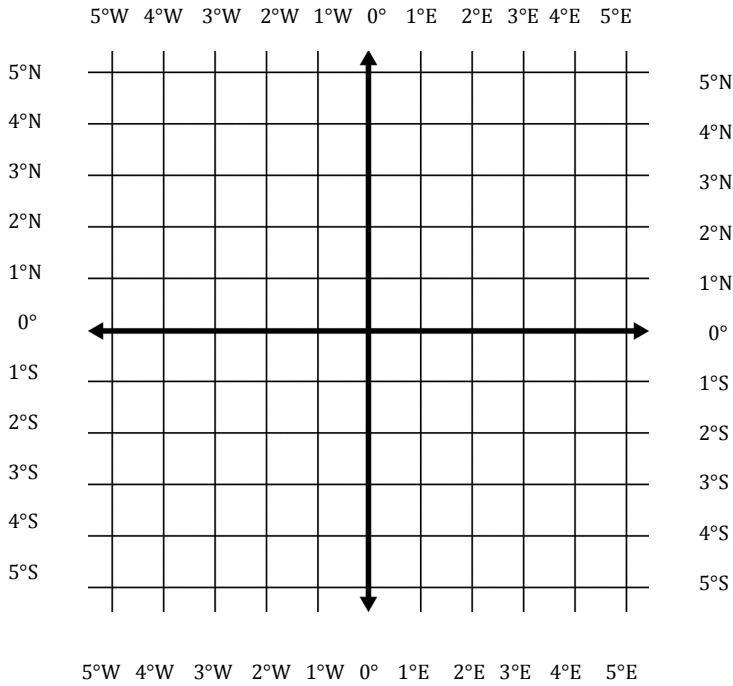
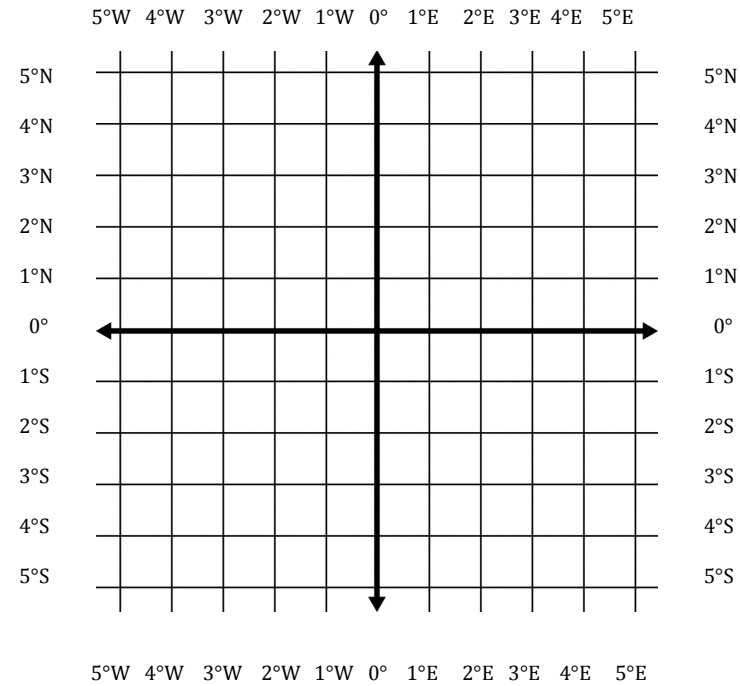




My Grid (My Treasure)

Directions

1. Mark the location of treasure on your grid by making a dot in a place where the grid lines cross. Mark 3 spots in 3 different quadrants (sections) of your grid. Record the locations below. Be sure to use the degree symbol and cardinal direction. Write °N or °S first. Then record the °W or °E. For example, 2° N, 1° W.

2. When your opponent guesses a location for your hidden treasure, mark an X on that location on your grid. If your opponent correctly guesses the location, you must tell him or her.
